1. Executive Summary

In November 2013, a preliminary part I of this report, detailing the stakeholder involvement up to and including July 2013, was published. This extended version of the report provides an overview of all stakeholder involvement and input for the duration of the project. Stakeholder involvement has mainly been performed through work packages (WPs) 2, 3, 6 and 8, whilst communication with stakeholders is also provided by WP9. Input to the project has been collected through exercises, workshops, surveys and person to person contact. Stakeholders have provided input on the identification of critical event parameters, operational functions and tools and organization of the PRACTICE toolbox, as well as prototype versions on the Toolbox itself. In particular, WP 6 has arranged three validation exercises. The participating Stakeholder organizations have been listed.

2. Introduction

This report summarizes the contact with and involvement of stakeholders in the PRACTICE project for the totality of the project period, covering all work packages (WPs). Focus has been on validation exercises, workshops, surveys and bilateral engagements. Where the stakeholder involvement has been documented in other project deliverables, we keep the information in the report at hand on an overview level.

Stakeholder involvement has been concentrated on

- participation in validation exercises, giving practical, organizational, operational and technical advice
- what tools to include and which to prioritize in the development
- how to best organize the PRACTICE toolbox (connect critical event parameters with functions, ensure the logical sequence of the use of functions, provide advice on the structure of the decision making part of the toolbox)
- improvement of the interface between the operator and the toolbox
- how to establish the use of the toolbox after the termination of the PRACTICE project.

A visual representation of the geographical distribution of the end-users involved throughout the project is given in Figure 1. The details of the form of involvement and the output from this are presented in the following chapters. The complete list of stakeholders is given in Annex I.
